

Background

The 113th Maine Legislature passed Public Law 1988, which permits a school board to declare a vacancy when one of its members is “absent without excuse from three consecutive regular...meetings.”

Policy

The Blue Hill School Committee policy on school vacancy due to members being absent as describe in Maine Statute is as follows:

The Chairman of the Board will ascertain the reason for absence from a member who has missed three consecutive regular board meetings. The chairman will discuss declaring a vacancy with the board if no reasonable explanation of absences is given. Action by the board will be final.
