Job Goals:

\*To deliver effective academic, functional and/or developmental programming to identified students in a combination of settings, from total pull-out to mainstreamed in the regular classroom;

\*To work with staff and parents to develop a range of effective interventions for students with unique needs;

Responsibilities:

1. Attend IEP meetings and complete IEP documents as required by MUSAR and School Union # 93 Special Education Department, and have appropriate paper work completed on schedule.
2. Consult with teachers, social workers, counselors, and other support personnel to develop effective programming for individual students and groups.
3. Evaluate and assess student behavioral and learning needs, design program options to meet those needs.
4. Work closely with parents.
5. Teach behavior, social skills, and conflict management to identified students in both a pull-out program and in the regular classroom.
6. Teach some or all academic subjects to students.
7. Seek additional training as needed, or as directed by administration.
8. Serve as a member of the PBIS Team.
9. Develop, monitor and adjust student behavior plans in collaboration with IEP Team members.
10. Participate in training for, and administer alternate assessments to assigned students.
11. Participate in all School Union #93 and Blue Hill Consolidated School Special Education trainings, workshops, and staff meetings.
12. Other related job duties as assigned by the administration, including meetings, committee work, planning, etc., which may take place outside the regular school day.
