Job Goal: The Blue Hill Consolidated School professional staff, with the help of the home and the community, will nurture and develop each student in mind, body, and character. More specifically, the music teacher will teach the sequential skills, content, and attitudes necessary to develop a musically literate student body through exposure, and enrichment opportunities in music.

Responsibilities:

1. Teaches elementary pupils music and social skills in a public educational system:
 - A. Instrumental lessons in grades 5-8 during the school day;
 - B. Large group instrumental ensembles in grades 5-8 during the school day;
 - C. Performance in classroom and concert settings for individuals and groups.
2. Organizes winter and spring concerts in cooperation with other music teacher(s).
3. Prepares teaching outline for course of study following union and state curriculum guidelines.
4. Uses a variety of teaching methods and aids to present subject matter to class.
5. Develops and administers assessments aligned with the curriculum and reports the results.
6. Assigns lessons, corrects papers, and evaluates other student products.
7. Maintains discipline in the classroom and other areas through positive but clear discipline practices.
8. Assists pupils when social and academic problems arise. Refers students to School Counselor, Student Assistance Team, Pupil Evaluation Team, Title I or to other appropriate specialists.
9. Discusses pupils' academic and social progress with parents and suggest remedial or accelerated action based on children's needs.
10. Communicates policies, expectations, and procedures to parents and students.
11. Coordinates with other staff members to enhance the programs of all students.
12. Contributes on a voluntary basis to extra-curricular and other school events.

13. Attends school plays, musical performances, athletic events, and graduation.
14. Contributes to policy decisions and curriculum design through faculty committees.
15. Advocates for children and educational programs in the community.
16. May assume the role of Team Leader on a rotating basis with other teachers and attends periodic meetings as part of that role.
17. Performs other tasks and assumes other responsibilities as the principal may assign that are not directly in conflict with the negotiated contract between the teachers association and the School Committee.
