To insure the safety of students, any child wishing to participate in varsity or JV sports must provide the school with a copy of a completed "Sports Participation Health Form". It is the parents' responsibility to arrange for a physical examination for this purpose. No child shall be denied participation in the sports program for any financial reason: if a child does not have a personal physician to complete the health form, it is the responsibility of the parent to inform the school so that other arrangements can be made for the required physical examination.
