

Policy Concerning Area School Students Participation in School Activities

The Blue Hill Consolidated School may invite students from area schools, either public or private, to participate in its extracurricular programs when additional participants are needed to provide the program in question. Extracurricular programs include clubs, musical activities, drama, intramural sports and interscholastic sports.

The school recognizes that in all other cases, when there are enough BHCS students to sustain a program, the addition of participants from other schools may have a negative impact by decreasing the attention, instruction, playing time, or opportunities to participate accorded to BHCS students. Therefore, students from other area schools will not be allowed to participate in school extracurricular activities unless additional participants are needed, as outlined above.

A student from another school will never displace, or take the place of, a BHCS student.

Which schools are invited to participate is left to the discretion of the principal, but he/she should consider whether or not a particular school already offers the program in question before inviting their participation.

When students from other area schools are invited to participate it will be on the same basis as BHCS students, and they must agree and conform to the same codes of conduct used at our school. Failure to do so may result in the student losing the privilege to participate.
