

**Blue Hill Consolidated School  
Maine Learning Technology Initiative (MLTI) Home-Use Policy**

1. Parents/guardians have the right to look at student laptops at any time.
2. Parents/guardians are permitted to use their students' assigned MLTI laptops so long as they agree to abide by the same program policy and procedures expected of the students.
3. Students must use the supplied laptop carrying cases to transport their MLTI laptops.
4. While MLTI laptops are off school grounds, students and parents are primarily responsible for the laptops.
5. Parents are expected to establish and enforce home use procedures with their students.
6. MLTI laptops are educational tools and are only to be used in that capacity, both on- and off-school grounds.
7. All student laptops are equipped with parental control software to monitor and filter internet usage on and off school grounds.
8. If parents/guardians do not feel comfortable serving as the responsible authority for the MLTI laptops while off school grounds, they may elect to decline take-home privileges for their students. If parents decline take-home privileges and later decide to allow them, a meeting with the school principal is required to instate or reinstate those privileges. Parents are encouraged to allow home use of the laptops for the full potential of the program to be realized. Students without take-home privileges may be at an educational disadvantage, and parents/guardians will be expected to work with the teachers to make other accommodations with regard to projects/assignments requiring use of the laptops.
