

**Policy Concerning Spectator Conduct and
Sportsmanship for Extracurricular Events
Blue Hill**

It is expected that spectators behave in a sportsmanlike manner during an extracurricular event. Those who don't may be asked to leave that event by the Athletic Director or other school staff member. Admission to subsequent school events may also be denied for up to a year after a school board hearing.

Examples of unsportsmanlike conduct include, but are not limited to:

- *using vulgar, obscene or offensive language towards another person or team
- *fighting or threatening another person
- *engaging in any activity which is disruptive
- *booing a team or individual
- *failure to obey instructions from supervisory personnel

All children below grade 3 are required to be under the direct supervision of an adult.
