The type of alternative placements that are available for children with disabilities and the number of handicapped children within each disability category who are serviced in each type of placement are provided annually to the Maine Department of Education, Division of Special Education on the EF-S-05 Enrollment of Exceptional Students (Pl 101-476 I.D.E.A) and EF-S-07 Request for Subsidy Allocation of Tuition and Board for Exceptional Children.
